During Voluck's tenure he served as a practice group leader of the labor and employment practice group, as well as co-managing partner for the Blue Bell Office, a role he held for 15 years. In addition, Voluck was a dedicated mentor to attorneys firmwide and utilized his gifts and resources to give back to his community. He has been an active and successful fundraiser for the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia; is a past chair of the Children's Hospital of Philadelphia's Annual Golf Classic; served as a volunteer lawyer for indigent musicians via Philadelphia Volunteer Lawyers for the Arts; and previously served as the Philadelphia On-Site Legal Consultant for Live Aid.
